This spring's health fair will be a drive-through event and will include food and personal protective equipment distribution. There will be free COVID-19 antigens and antibodies testing for adults as well as free COVID-19 vaccines for those with an appointment (call 513-557-7249 for English/Español). The St. Elizabeth mammography van will be performing free mammograms by appointment only (call 513-557-7249 for English/Español). Healthy Moms and Babes will be distributing prenatal vitamins and diapers (donated by Sweet Cheeks) to their clients.
