## Santa Maria Community Services Hosts COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic on May 15, 2021

CINCINNATI, OH – Santa Maria Community Services, Inc. is pleased to announce its COVID-19 vaccine clinic. The free vaccine clinic will take place on Saturday, May 15, 2021 from 10 a.m. – 1 p.m. at the Price Hill Recreation Center located at 959 Hawthorne Avenue, Cincinnati, OH 45205.

The first dose of the Pfizer vaccine will be available on a walk-in basis starting at 10 a.m. Anyone 16 years of age or older is eligible. Santa Maria will also be administering the second dose of the vaccine for those who already received the first dose during our health fair (an appointment would have been scheduled at that time). This event will also include food distribution!

Part of this commitment includes offering the opportunity to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. Vaccination is a vitally important step in controlling this pandemic," said H.A.
