The POP program is a family-focused kindergarten-readiness program that works collaboratively with families, schools, and the community and bases its work on home visitations. By building reading, language, and social skills, POP seeks to create a seamless transition into school for preschool-age children while ensuring that barriers to school readiness are removed.

Research shows that over 98% of families enrolled in Santa Maria's programs receive Medicaid and fewer than 30% of the parents in POP have a high school diploma. Therefore, these children tend to fall behind their peers in reading and literacy skills, which impacts their lives in every area of education throughout their school years and beyond.

"We are so pleased to receive another philanthropic grant from the PNC Foundation that will help the sustainability of this vital program," says H.A.
