Santa Maria Community Services, Inc. is excited to announce a \$40,000 grant from the Josephine S. Russell Charitable Trust to support its Workforce Development program. This funding will help advance the organization's mission to empower Price Hill families in their pursuit of self-sufficiency.

The Workforce Development program provides financial literacy training, education, income supports, and employment services to economically disadvantaged individuals in Cincinnati's Price Hill neighborhood. This area faces significant challenges, including high poverty rates, low educational attainment, and unemployment, compounded by housing instability and rising living costs. People of color are disproportionately affected by these barriers.

To address these issues, the program offers personalized coaching and resources designed to help participants achieve long-term financial stability. In partnership with LISC, Santa Maria utilizes the evidence-based Financial Opportunity Center model, focusing on three key goals: enhancing economic stability through financial and employment coaching, increasing access to essential resources, and supporting participants in securing and maintaining stable, unsubsidized employment.
