CINCINNATI, OH - Santa Maria Community Services, Inc. is honored to announce the receipt of a \$75,000 grant from The Charles H. Dater Foundation, Inc. through its Dater4Kids initiative.

This generous grant will help Santa Maria Community Services continue to support the growth and development of its Youth Development program in Price Hill, including its social and emotional skills group. The program provides at-risk youth ages 10-16 with structured social-emotional learning, after-school academic enrichment opportunities, and family support services that strengthen stability and connection.

The Youth Development Program features group-based lessons and activities that emphasize peer resistance, coping, interpersonal, and peaceful conflict resolution skills. These sessions aim to help youth share what they learn, build trust within their families, gain parental support, and better understand the challenges that affect family stability.

Other features of the Youth Development program include after-school recreation, skills classes in areas such as cooking, gardening, music production, cosmetology, research, and statistics, as well as community volunteering and summer learning opportunities. Santa Maria partners with organizations such as Meiser's to provide teens with job and leadership experience, the Community Learning Center Institute and Community Matters to offer youth community engagement and learning opportunities, and Best Point to ensure participants receive essential mental health support for academic and social success.
